

Griff's Cavern House Policy

Griff's Cavern is a campus Restaurant / Bar operated by the Student Representative Council of St. Clair College, located in the Student Centre. Our goal is to provide a friendly atmosphere with courteous efficient service: offering food, beverages and entertainment at a reasonable cost. In recognition of our customers we vow to remain sensitive to their need and will work to create an atmosphere where they feel at home amongst friends.

However, in keeping with the spirit of friendship, we, as a licensee, understand that we have additional responsibilities. At Griff's we fully support the practice of responsible beverage service and place the safety and well being of our guests as our first priority. It is for this reason that we have developed the following policies to ensure the safety, privacy and enjoyment of all staff and patrons.

1. We accept only government issued forms of I.D. as proof of age.
2. Proof of age must be shown prior to alcoholic beverage service.
3. We reserve the right to examine personal effects upon entry to ensure compliance with L.L.B.O. regulations
4. We reserve the right to refuse entry or service to any patron when deemed intoxicated or threatening to the well being of operation.
5. Aggressive behaviour or conduct perceived dangerous to the safety of other guests or staff will not be permitted.
6. No food or beverages will be allowed on the dance floor.
7. No smoking anywhere in the building.
8. No alcoholic beverages may be taken or consumed outside of licensed areas.
9. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
10. Any acts resulting in damage to the establishment will be reported to the police.
11. Last call in the establishment may vary but will not be any later than 1:45 a.m. No alcohol will be served after 2:00a.m.
12. The house reserves the right to limit sale to 1 standard drink or equivalent per customer at any time.
13. Physical or verbal harassment of employees or guests will not be tolerated.
14. Racial or sexist behaviour is unacceptable.
15. Under age drinking is not tolerated. Anyone supplying alcohol to minors will be reported to the proper authorities.
